

Former Prime Minister Malcolm Fraser made famous the phrase: "Life was not meant to be easy". The context was political debate no doubt centering on taxes and charges. Christians hardly needed to be reminded of this truth which has applied since The Fall in Genesis 3.

Living in a fallen world is never easy and it can be a constant pain. Sin and temptations abound and being a believer does not guarantee a trouble-free existence, in fact the reverse can apply and does for may many Christians especially in the persecuted Church.

James writes about Christian trials and temptations and offering excellent advice and warnings. Ch 1 V2-3 says: "Consider it all joy, my brethren when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance." Trials allowed by God to refine us. V12 then adds "Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial..."

James also writes about seeking Godly wisdom in life's journey. In V13 he offers the warning: "Let no one say when he is tempted 'I am being tempted by God'; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and he Himself does not tempt anyone."

Making distinctions between the two aspects of Christian living can be a challenge itself but James' line is clear.

Proverbs 16:20 reads "He who gives attention to the word will find good. And blessed is who trusts in the Lord."

CH Spurgeon says on the matter of Wisdom "Lord, walk with me in the garden this evening and teach me the wisdom of faith."

Life is rarely easy, but it can still be joyous when we live close to the Lord.
