

A couple of weeks ago I mentioned 4 tips for evangelism (out of a list of 10) from Tim Keller. Since then, a number of people have spoken to me about how they have offered to pray for others (and prayer was welcomed!) and other recent experiences in sharing the hope they have in Jesus Christ. To complete the 10, here's the rest of Keller's list.

- 1. Let people around you know you are a Christian (in a natural, unforced way).
- 2. Ask friends about their faith and just listen!
- 3. Listen to your friends' problems maybe offer to pray for them.
- 4. Share your problems with others testify to how your faith helps you.
- 5. Give them a book to read.
- 6. Share your story.
- 7. Answer objections and questions.
- 8. Invite them to a church event.
- 9. Offer to read the Bible with them.
- 10. Take them to an explore course.

1-2 is about awareness raising, from points 2 onwards the gospel (or parts of it) are shared in different ways. Keller advises that we generally start with 1-4, then with interested people we move to 5-7, and then 8-10. He advises that it is worth spending time in the earlier points to lay a better groundwork that they might be more receptive in later points. Even for a keen person, it often takes months and years going through the various points multiple times for them to make a commitment to follow Christ.

Who can you pray for today and get the topic of faith and Jesus Christ on the agenda?
