As the vaccination rates increase in NSW, we look forward to returning from lockdown. I know that many of us are planning when we might see family and friends again

Over the past few weeks, following consultation with the Sydney Anglican Diocese, the wardens and I have discussed the reopening of church. In the NSW governments plan, there are 3 significant points to come: 70% double vaccination, 80% double vaccination and December 1.

We are planning on returning to church following the 80% vaccination date. This is estimated to be **Sunday October 31**, with **both 9:30am and 5pm services**.

At 80% a number of significant changes occur. We will be able to open up to both vaccinated and unvaccinated people over 16. Children will be able to attend ministries without vaccinated parents present onsite (Kids Club, Refuge).

Prior to the 80% vaccination date on about Sunday October 31, we would need to <u>check everyone</u> at the door, and 'take reasonable steps to ensure that an unvaccinated adult is not on the premises,' which we don't think is a viable option.

Whenever we open, there will be both restrictions and risks. Some of us may be concerned by the restrictions, others more concerned about the risks. But it must be acknowledged that we never live our life free of either restriction or risk. In this context we plan, make decisions, respond and trust the Lord.

After opening, livestream will still be available for people if you need to stay at home because of illness, being immune compromised or other reasons.

In all this, we desire to gather together for encouragement (Hebrews 10:24-25), remain united (Colossians 3:15-17), love one another (Philippians 2:1-5), and be obedient to the government (Romans 13:1-7). Please pray for these things as we move towards reopening.
