Return to church gatherings

Our Sunday services will recommence (for everyone, regardless of vaccination status) next week on **31st October, at 9:30am and 5pm**. Due to 4m2 requirements we will have limited numbers per service. Please book for the 9:30am and 5pm service, by contacting the office. If you cannot attend let us know so we can allocate space to someone else.

As we do open again, there will be a number of things we need to do in order to ensure our church is a safe place. Here are some of the things we are doing:

- ensuring good ventilation flows by having windows and doors open.
- limiting the number of people in the room to the current covid density limits.
- requiring a COVID check in (QR code or sign in) upon arrival.
- encouraging physical distancing.
- masks will need to be worn indoors for those over 12.
- there will be no congregation singing. However you can hum along to the music.
- we will have morning tea/afternoon tea at 9:30am and 5pm services. This will be from the servery in the back hall, with volunteers serving the food and drink. We will encourage people to move outside if possible, with limited seating available.
- our livestream will continue of the 9:30 service for those unable to attend for any reason.
- frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned after each service.
