

University of Wollongong Mission 2021

From December 10-12 (Friday-Sunday morning) we will be visited by a mission team from Wollongong University. This follows on from their National Training Event (NTE) conference, held each year with other university groups.

At the conference, the students are taught each year with a program that builds through Exegesis (understanding a Bible passage in context), Biblical Theology (Bible overview), Systematic Theology, and each time how to teach what they have learned. The mission following the conference sends these students out to churches across Australia nearby their universities.

Last year we had a small team visit, which was great for evangelism, and the encouragement of both our church and the team.

This year the team will come to the Sunday morning service, Gingerbread house event, Kids Club, Refuge Youth Group, doorknock and flyer houses, and even put on a car wash! This mission is not just about them coming to us, but us partnering together in the gospel of Jesus. Chapter 1 of Philippians testifies to the joy of the apostle Paul in their – partnership in the gospel, growth in knowledge and insight of Jesus, preaching of Jesus Christ. I hope that this team encourages you in this way.

There are some practical things we can do to support the mission:

- 1. Speak to the team members, get to know them and encourage them in their faith, and in their life and university studies.
- 2. Feed them!
 - a. We will provide lunch on Saturday and Sunday
 - b. A supply of morning and afternoon tea which they can eat as they see fit
 - c. Hosting team members for dinner on Saturday night, in groups of 2-3
