

The blessing of unity

It is a wonderful thing that even though we are all so different, in Christ we can come together in unity to praise the Lord. In Old Testament Israel, all the people from each tribe of the nation would come together to worship the Lord. Despite the history between many of them, they would gather at the temple in Jerusalem at the festivals where the covenant people of God would seek divine grace. Psalm 133 focuses on this unity:

How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron's beard, down on the collar of his robe. It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion. For there the LORD bestows his blessing, even life forevermore.

When we gather together as a church we too stand in the line of God's people, assembled as his covenant people in unity under him. Some weeks it may seem very normal and mundane, but it is remarkable, as Hebrews 12:22-24 reminds us:

But you have come to Mount Zion, to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the Judge of all, to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Through faith in Jesus Christ, this is who and what we are united around: God the judge and Jesus the mediator seated in the heavenly Jerusalem. From there the Lord bestows his blessing to us, even life forevermore.
