### Contactless payment now available at church

If you normally pay for things at church using cash, from this week there'll be a contactless "tap & go" option for you to use when you attend church or an event.

This simply involves typing in amount on our new Square payment device (located next to the coffee machine in the fover), and then tapping (or inserting) a credit or debit card on the payment device. If you have a mobile device set up for contactless payment (eg. phone or watch), you can also use that. You can also receive a receipt if vou wish.
