On Mother's Day, we give thanks to God for our mothers. And we can honour them.

The 5th commandment urged the Israelites to honour their mothers, and Paul says the same for Christians in Ephesians 6:1-3:

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honour your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."

Honouring our mother will look different at different times of our life. Whether we are a child, or an adult. Whether we are cared by our mother when we are young, or whether we are caring for her in her old age. Whether she is close to us, or estranged. Whether she is living, or no longer alive.

The command forces us to take seriously the relationship with the person we have spent most time with – for our mothers, even from the womb! Through our mothers, we have been given life.

If your mother is no longer with you, is there something you could give thanks to God for her, in prayer? If she is alive, what else could you add, to honour her?

How can you thank God and honour your mother today?
