Life is dominated by warnings. For example, **Food**: May contain gluten. **Clothing**: Do not tumble dry. **Vehicles**: Do not use E10 fuel. **Driving**: Wrong-way go back. **TV programs**: May contain violence, and so they go on endlessly.

Has is it been any different since The Fall? <u>Adam</u> and <u>Eve</u> were warned not to eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil; in fact, they were not to go anywhere near it, but they did, and we still wear the consequences.

God gave constant warnings to His special people in the Old Testament. In the New, they continued. In <u>Mark 8:36</u> Jesus warned: "What does it profit a man to gain the whole world, and forfeit his soul?" In <u>Luke 16:31</u> dealing with the Rich Man and Lazarus, He warned: "... If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead."

Later in Luke 18:22, Jesus warned The Rich Young Ruler: "One thing you still lack; sell all that you possess and distribute it to the poor and you shall have treasure in heaven; and come follow me."

One life warning speaks volumes: **Life**: Be warned it may end suddenly and are you ready for Eternity? Many around us ignore the reality of death as Sam pointed out last week. What hope do they have apart from Jesus?

Christians have the only hope that lasts into Eternity with God (in Heaven). The alternative (Hell without God) has nothing to recommend it.
