Galatians majors on issues of salvation and holiness in Jesus Christ and rewards focused study.
- Secret Thoughts of an Unlikely Convert by Rosaria Butterfield. A well written autobiography of how Butterfield a lesbian, professor of English and women's studies, and someone who despised Christians came to follow Christ and her wrestling with different aspects of Christian faith and culture.
