Psalm 27:14 Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage;

wait for the LORD!

Psalm 40:1 I waited patiently for the LORD; he inclined to me and heard my cry.

Psalm 62:5 For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him.

Psalm 130:5 I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in his word I hope....

Sometimes God places us in situations where we do not know what to do. However, we still feel the need to do something... and therein lies the problem! We want to be in control! Waiting forces us to acknowledge God is in control, exercises our patience and drives us to trust Him for the outcome and its timing. Trusting in His perfect love for us is the key to waiting patiently and expectantly.
