Some weeks you can see that all the balls you are juggling will hit the ground, and you just wonder where they will land. It causes me to take to heart the words of Jesus in Matthew 6:33-34:

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

In my Bible reading this morning I was directed to the first chapters of Joshua. With the uncertainty of what crossing over into the promised land will bring, God repeatedly says to Joshua and the people, 'Be strong and courageous.' In facing their enemies, in keeping the law, in obeying Joshua's leadership, they should be strong and courageous. But these things are difficult and anxiety inducing. How can they do it? Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1:9)

Our situation is not like theirs, but we too have many challenges in life. Like the Israelites, we too can be strong and courageous for we have the constant presence of God with us, even his Spirit in us. God is sovereign over all we cannot handle and cannot forsee.

I don't know what you face, but do not forget that God is with you wherever you go, and will bring you through all the mess of life. In Jesus, we can be strong and courageous. For he has overcome the world, sin and death; he is with us to the end of the age; and he and will draw all things together for good in his future kingdom.
