This week the 4th Global Anglican Future Conference (GAFCON) was held in Kigali, Rwanda. 1300 delegates from 53 nations gathered together. Men, women, lay and clergy – all followers of Jesus Christ.

The GAFCON movement is a global family of authentic Anglicans standing together to retain and restore the Bible to the heart of the Anglican Communion. Its mission is to guard the unchanging, transforming Gospel of Jesus Christ and to proclaim Him to the world. It is founded on the Bible, bound together by the Jerusalem statement and declaration of 2008, and led by a Primates Council, which represents the majority of the world's Anglicans.

GAFCON works to guard and proclaim the unchanging, transforming Gospel through biblically faithful preaching and teaching which frees our churches to make disciples by clear and certain witness to Jesus Christ in all the world.

Please pray that meeting and efforts at renewal are blessed by the Lord God for the revitalisation of the Anglican church around the world.


