

Instructing children about God and his salvation

Raising children in the faith involves teaching them about God and his salvation. In Deuteronomy 6:20-21, we read:

In the future, when your son asks you, "What is the meaning of the stipulations, decrees and laws the LORD our God has commanded you?" tell him: "We were slaves of Pharaoh in Egypt, but the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

In explaining the 'why' of a way of life, history is very important. For God's people in the Old Testament, it was his saving work of the Exodus that formed them as a nation. Telling this story reminded them of their past salvation, from being oppressed slaves, to their new way of life, freed by God.

For Christians, Jesus' death and resurrection is God's greater saving work - from sin and death. By teaching about this, Christian parents explain their family patterns and behaviours (cf. Deut. 6:22-25). Parents therefore should prioritise teaching the Bible. This firstly is about knowing God - his person and work in the world. Secondly it is about our response and behaviour. The order is important, for efforts to teach 'good morals and values' without knowing God put the cart before the horse. In fact, the most valuable part of the Christian faith is a relationship with God!

Today, there are many quality Bibles available for children of different ages. Reading these with children can often bring unexpected learning for parents. One friend commented that she gained a greater grasp of cohesive storyline of the Bible while reading the Jesus Storybook Bible with her kids.

If you'd like a suggestion for an age appropriate children's Bible or Christian book, speak to Susan. There are plenty to borrow and test out from the shelf in the back hall, or you can purchase one from the book stall.
