

Modelling our faith

When discipling others, sometimes we explicitly teach, yet at all times we implicitly model what it means to live for Jesus. This occurs across all the ages and stages in a church congregation, and is particularly relevant for Christian parents raising children. Paul writes:

Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ. (1 Corinthians 11:1)

Taking responsibility for our own love of Christ and holiness, is an important way to grow others. This is not about perfection, but the ever-constant endeavour to follow the Lord Jesus. When we are loving, joyful, gracious to others, gentle, self-controlled, forgiving and patient, we set an example of Christlikeness, and display what it means to follow him. Thinking as a parent, in the moments when I am impatient, cranky, harsh (and all the rest), how do I model the importance and means of regaining control of myself, changing my behaviour and apologising to those I have treated poorly? Likewise forgiving others, and not being embittered towards them? These actions are good for our relationships in the first instance, but also are a teaching moment. This is important for adult Christians to learn, and vital for children.

Our Christian faith is lived out between me and God, and also in relation to other people. We may fixate on an individualistic faith, and not realise the effect we have on the network of people and relationships around us. Our Christlikeness is a blessing, and can encourage others, and cause them to change for the better in following him.

Humanity is far from perfect, in fact, sinful and evil. Yet Jesus dwelt among us, saved us and set an example for us. He renews us now, through the power of the Holy Spirit. And he works through each of us, one towards another, to live with Christ as Lord of our lives.

Hungering is not about trying to earn what is a gift, but being aware of having too much world and not enough Word in our lives. We need daily input into our spirits; they get battered every day by so much around us. Let's be intentional in our faith.
