In the Bible the word *walk* is used to summarise the characteristics or tenor of our life... what motivates us, what we value most, our attitudes, affections, words and actions, and to what we give our time and effort.

Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked...

Isaiah 2:5 O house of Jacob, come, let us walk in the light of the LORD.

Micah 6:8 ... what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love

kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?

Romans 6:4 ...just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father,

we too might walk in newness of life.

2 Corinthians 5:6 ...We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from

the Lord, (7) for we walk by faith, not by sight.

Galatians 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit...

Ephesians 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ loved us...

Ephesians 5:8 ...now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light


