

'The Jesus I Never Knew' - Jodi's story

What happens when the Jesus you thought you knew turns out to be someone far greater? In this story from Naomi Reed's 'Every Moment, Everywhere', Jodi discovers grace she could never earn and a God who truly fixes what we cannot.

"When I was 11, our mother died. It was sudden and unexpected. I'm the eldest of four, with a significantly disabled younger sister and two younger brothers. Afterwards, I carried a lot of hurt.

After school, I went to university in Albury, country New South Wales, and I had to find my own accommodation. I stumbled across a Presbyterian church that rented out their manse to students. It was directly across from the uni bar, so I applied! In the application, you had to say you were a Christian, and I lied. I didn't think there were any real Christians anymore!

But when I got there, it took me about three weeks to realise that three of the students were actually Christians. There was one girl who was kind and friendly... She would pray to God and read her Bible. She spoke about God as if he was someone she knew quite well. I was really intrigued by that. Eventually I went with her to campus Bible study. They were reading the Gospel of John together... I thought, 'Wow, this is not the Jesus I knew!' I remember the first time I read Romans 8:1. It really resonated with me. We are not condemned. There is nothing his death cannot cover! We can't fix it ourselves, but he can."

Jodi's story reminds us that God often works through simple, genuine friendship. May we live in such a way that our love for Jesus naturally overflows into the lives of those around us.
