

The Church of England at Oak Flats – building dedication in 1951

Although uncertain, it seems that church services began to be held at Oak Flats, by the Rev. Gee in 1938-39. Later, the Rev. Edwards, when Rector of Jamberoo, held services at a Public Hall, until it was demolished, and they lapsed for several years. Another beginning was made by the Rev. Gee just before he left Dapto Parish, and, with the permission of Mrs. T. Kerr, the first service was held at the Post Office Store on September 21st, 1947. A Building Fund was opened with a donation of £100 from Mr. W. H. Waters. In February, 1949, the Right Rev. G. H. Cranswick, visited the centre, and was the first Bishop to preach at Oak Flats. When Mrs. Kerr left the district, Church services were held at the home of Mr. W. H. Waters, and there a Sunday School was started. A block of land in Fisher Street was then given by a Dapto parishioner, but there was some delay before a Church building could be started.

In May, 1950, the Progress Hall became the meeting-place for Church services and for the growing Sunday School, and an appeal was made for donations to the Building Fund. The foundation stone of the building was set by Mr. Webb on Advent Sunday, December 3rd, 1950, the Sunday nearest St. Andrew's Day. The Ven. Begbie, Archdeacon of Camden and Rural Dean of Wollongong, gave the address, the text being that engraved on the foundation stone, Nehemiah 2:20. Through the help of Albion Park Church Committee, the adjoining block of land was purchased in May, 1951, thus providing for a future building programme.

St. Andrew's School Church is of brick with tiled roof, and is 40 feet long and 24 feet wide. The building cost £2,342, including fees, but excluding furnishings (which are valued at about £350). Of this amount £1,600 is a private loan obtained through the Parish Council, and £500 is from the Church Building Loans Fund. So far £165 has been given by Oak Flat parishioners and £120 from the rest of the parish.

The visit of the Archbishop of Sydney to dedicate the Church is an occasion for great rejoicing among the Oak Flats people, and parishioners in general share with them in the realisation of the hopes of many years.
