School Holiday Kids Club

Coming up on Friday July 17th, we will be running a Kids Holiday Club for children in Kindergarten to Grade 6. It will have a science theme, leading to a teaching focus about Jesus being the Lord and God who created and runs the universe, and who entered the world to save us.

But if anyone is willing to help with the food preparation on the day that would be wonderful. Furthermore, the greatest assistance would be your prayers that the many keen and interested children in our area would be able to come and hear about Jesus, and find new and everlasting life in him.
